

**YRHOA Annual Meeting Minutes**  
**17 July 2010**

The YRHOA 2010 Annual Meeting was called to order at 10:10 am at Lester Miller's home. Enough members and proxies were present to form a quorum. The minutes of the last annual meeting were read and entered into record.

**Treasurer's Report.** Bob Cherry summarized the past year's financial activity and projections of costs for the coming year. (Please see attached statements).

**Old Business.**

There are still some questions regarding the new 911 numbering system. All members should know their new 911 number, as this information was sent out in the March minutes. To reiterate the required actions to date:

If you have a landline phone, CALL YOUR PHONE COMPANY to correlate your phone number with your new address. This allows emergency responders to immediately know your location if you call for help.

If you have a security system, CALL YOUR SECURITY SYSTEM PROVIDER and provide them your new address so that they may coordinate with emergency providers.

If you rent your property, LET YOUR RENTERS/RENTAL COMPANY know so that they may get emergency help if necessary. Post your 911 number conspicuously in your home.

You should also call other utility providers to ensure they have the 911 address. BE CAREFUL NOT TO CHANGE YOUR BILLING ADDRESS WHEN YOU DO THIS!

If you have mail delivered to your house, DO NOT CALL THE POST OFFICE YET as they are still using the old addresses and will transition at a later date.

The board hopes to place new signs on each property with the 911 numbers in the spring. The signs will be placed 6-12 feet from the end of the driveway. We are hoping to come up with aesthetically pleasing signs which reflect the rustic nature of Yoakum Run. If any members have any suggestions for signs please don't hesitate to forward them to any board member.

**New Business.**

We will probably need to clear ditches along the roadsides prior to winter. Bob Rubenstein has offered to find out who is responsible for this on the main road.

The members voted to make a donation of \$500 to the Canaan Valley Fire Department. We'd also like to remind you to have your chimneys swept and checked before winter weather sets in.

The results of our election were tabulated and Lester Miller, Bob Rubenstein and Susan Butler will retain their positions for another two-year term. The next meeting will be on October 2 at Lester Miller's house.
